

TIP

SOLO CARBURATOR RETAINING SCREWS



It has been brought to our attention that it is very easy to strip out the two carburetor retaining screws that thread into the bakelite insulating block on the Solo model 137, 142 and the 154 engines used on the Strikemaster ice Augers.

When reinstalling these two 5 x 50mm self tapping screws, install them by hand and first turn them a ½ turn counter clockwise before turning them clockwise to install them. This will align the threads with the previously cut threads and prevent the screws from cutting new threads in the insulating block. Torque to 18-20 in/lbs with a T25 Torx bit.

Screws go in dry. Do not use a thread locker (Loctite).
